Should We Change Article 9?



Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe is now working on changing article 9 of the Japanese constitution. It has been 71 years since they made it. Article 9 is one of the most important clauses, as it shows Japan won't have military forces, never going to take part in war and also not going to attack another country. The only force allowed is for protecting Japan, called Self Defense Force (SDF). They have the minimum necessary equipment for protecting Japan so, they are not allowed to attack another country in a combat, there are some constitution scholars that say of the SDF has too much power and equipment recently, so it can be a military forces of Japan, and if that is so, it is illegal by the constitution.

So far, no Japanese prime minister has tried to change the constitution, so the Japanese government is having intense discussion about it right now. Japanese citizens

opinion is also divided about whether or not they agree with changing article 9. We thought, "What would foreigners think about changing article 9?" We took questionnaire to both foreigners and Japanese about changing article 9. According to our questionnaire, we had 9 out of 16 people that agree with changing the Japanese constitution article 9. Here are some opinions "The Japanese constitution is better to be changed, because if Japan got a larger military and supported allies, it will be a great defensive ally for those countries which have good relationship with Japan" or "It is unfriendly to neighboring countries. If Japan doesn't cooperate take part in a war that the neighbor country has, that could cause a problem between that country and Japan. We asked An American man that works in Japan teaching English to Japanese senior people, He said "well, I used to be in the US

military so my opinion is a little conservative, but I think Japan constitutions article 9 is not enough for now. It was a great paper at that time. But the world is changing bit by bit. So I think Japan should change too. I think to have a strong military can be the most effective defensive insurance for a country. So Japan should have military forces just in case of an emergency situation."

After we asked foreigners, we asked same question to Japanese people half of them said "we should change the way we interpret this article. "As a result of the opinions agreeing with this idea, it seems many Japan should have military forces to protect them self and neighbor countries and also to keep good relationship between them.

The rest of the people disagreed with changing article 9. They had reasons the like "It is safer for Japanese people to stick with article 9." There were also

opinions like "There is no other country like Japan. So I want Japan to be a good example as the most peaceful country in the world by continuing not to have military forces. Japanese also said the same thing after the foreigners.

In summary, from the result of our questionnaire we learned that the opinion is broken among foreigners same as Japan. We can say that war is a big mistakes we have made in human history, and we should not have war again. The constitution is essential in our life. So, we want to think about the constitution amendment well.

Through this survey, current situation in Japan was understood. Japan has many things to be proud of. But also Japan has many things to improve, but Japanese people compensates for that with

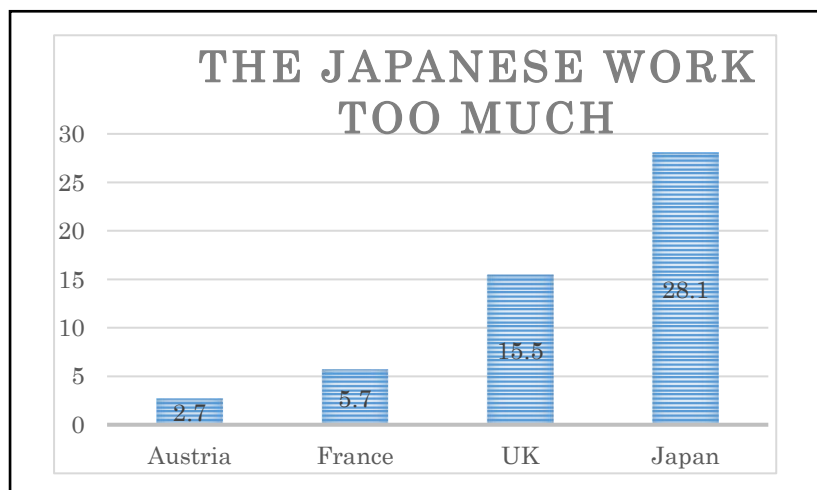
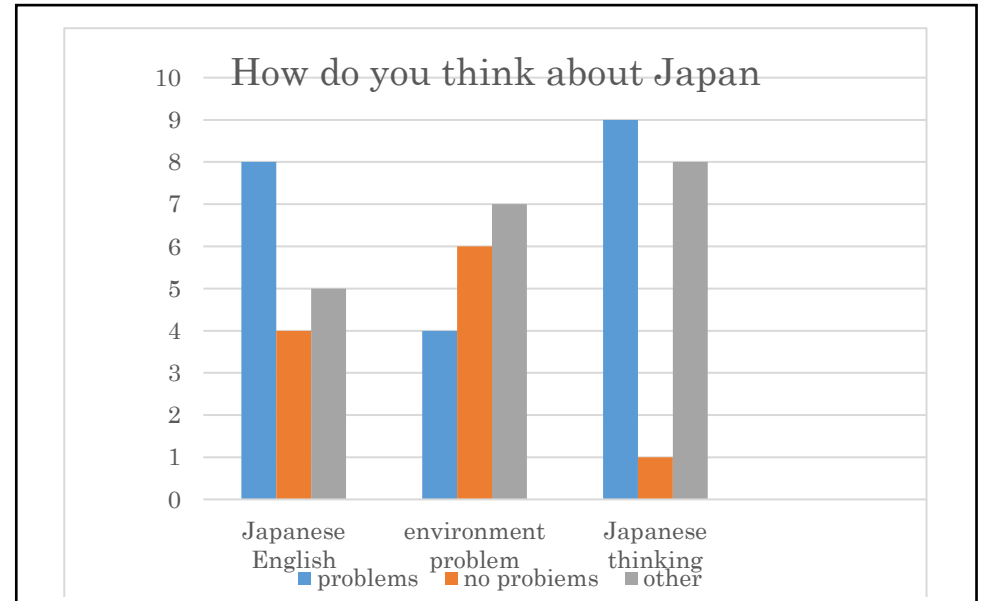

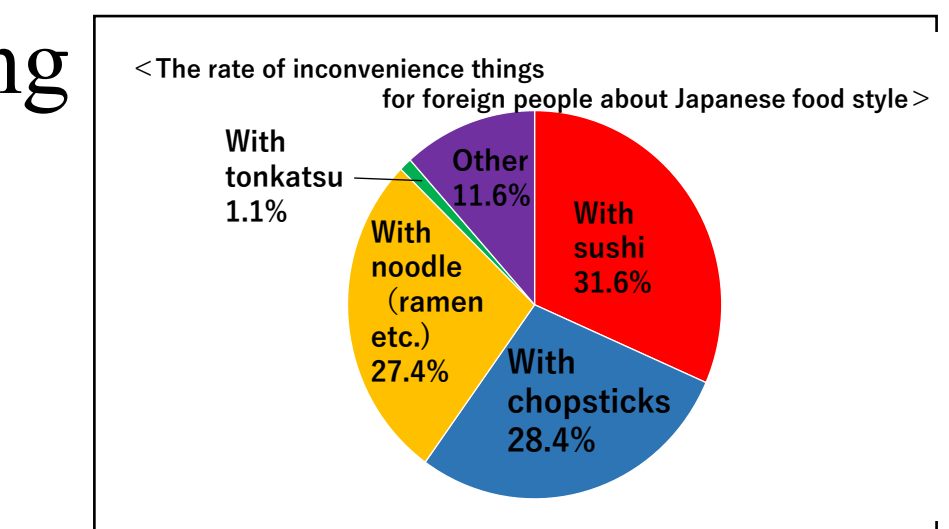
“OMOTENASHI” and the Japanese way of dining
